### **A Summary of BPCs Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes for the Approval of the Colleges Mission Statement**

Buraydah Colleges as one of higher education private institutions came as a fruit of the policy of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques in encouraging the private sector to play a distinct role in the field of higher education according to Vision 2030.
